 The ball should be driven into the hole with a golf stick called a club. Individual clubs must be used to move the ball from each spot. Golf has been labeled as a sport for the elite. Bharath from Chennai has set up such a golf game in an indoor sports hall for everyone to play. His indoor golf playground called 'Golf's Edge' is located in an apartment building in Alwarpet, Chennai.

"I am basically a golfer. I have been playing this game since I was nine years old. We went to Zambia because of my father's work. That is where I learned golf. I continued to practice even after coming to India. After completing my studies abroad, I worked in a corporate company. I also worked as an editor in a golf magazine and that's when I got to know Hari Natarajan, who and I started a company called 'D Time Ventures' in 2014.

Golf was generally reserved for the elite. Many people don't know the basic details about this game. It is our aim that even those who have never touched a golf club should be able to hold it in their hand and play the game. If we tell them that we are training them for this, no one will come. One is that it costs more. Another thing is to set aside personal time for it. We wanted to bring this game indoors to be fun yet relaxing and create a social environment for them. When we told our proposal to the apartment builders, they were very enthusiastic. Most of the community houses have gym, greengrocer, swimming pool, supermarket as their selling point. When they were told it was indoor golf, they welcomed it with great enthusiasm. After apartments, we also look it to corporates. It became a good field for them to relax in between work. "We have done 85 projects," he said, adding that this sports center in Chennai was the beginning for them.

"An architect builds houses for many but wants to build a dream house for himself. That's what we wanted. Although we have set it up in many places, we wanted to set up something for ourselves. By that time I was settled in Chennai. People of Chennai play cricket and football but never get a chance to play golf. We have made it so that everyone can enjoy playing this game.

It is a virtual golf game.

But no 3D. Do not wear virtual glasses on the eyes. There is no need for that.

Hit the ball with a real golf club. It looks like it's possible indoors. All we use are real golf clubs and balls. There are a total of 14 types of clubs. Each is used to hit the ball a certain distance. There will be a screen in front of you. It is a normal projector screen. Made to not tear no matter how fast the ball is hit. It will show the golf course you want to play. Almost 150,000 of the most popular golf courses in the world can be recorded online

Can. You can choose the ground of your choice.

At least 10 to 20 feet between you and

the screen. A simulator is mounted above where you hit the ball.

It has a camera and sensor

attached to it. It will

sensor the ball and record it on

camera. When you are ready

to hit the ball, the simulator

will say ready. Next you have

to bounce the ball towards

the screen. It will take a picture

of how far the ball has traveled

on the field on the screen and

show you in slow motion.

That is, how many yards the

ball has traveled. Distance

between ball and pit. You can see on

the screen how much chance you

have to put the ball into the hole.

It is on one side and on the

other side we have set it in a

small size in the form of turf.

There are five pits in front of

you and posts here and there.

You have to put the ball in

all these five holes. You

can also hit the ball at the

near post. This is called

pudding. The club for

this is called butter

A game of indoor golf turned
out to be great relaxation. It
has been popular in countries
like America, Europe, Japan
and Korea for the past three
years. Since this is the first Arimu

Gum in Chennai, many people
come here to play. You can play
here from Tuesday to Sunday
from 10 am to 10 pm. For
our regular customers, admission
is at 7 am. One slot is one hour.
It should be booked in advance.

Only you can play here at that
time. Others are not allowed. We
allow a maximum of eight
people in groups. Rs.900 per hour
for an individual, Rs.1400
for two people and Rs.1700
for a group. As the first-time
visitors are given personal
training, they have to pay a fee
of Rs.250. 8500 for six months
for 12 hours package. They
can play their 12 hours

whenever they want. Currently we are
operating in Alwarpet. Next
there is an intention to open
branches in OMR, Anna Nagar.
There is also the idea of
franchising. There is also an intention to
work in partnership with schools.
Now that the holiday season
is about to start, we are
going to start the summer camp
as well," said Bharath.
